Jacqueline Ruiz is an internationally known, award-winning entrepreneur and publishing magnate. She is considered to be a Latina storytelling pioneer and a champion of Latina aviation and youth.

Jackie immigrated to the U.S. from Mexico City at the age of 14 and learned English in months. After surviving cancer twice, Jackie dedicated herself to inspiring and empowering others through her work. She founded the award-winning public relations firm JJR Marketing in 2006, followed by Fig Factor Media in 2014. Jackie has authored more than 30 books and published more than 500 for authors across 34 countries, beginning in 2015 with *Today's Inspired Latina*. The book was the first in a suite of Latina anthologies in which she has amassed the most extensive collection of Latina stories of adversity and inspiration over several multi-volume series. Her anthologies include *Latinas Rising Up in HR*, *Latinas in Construction*, *Latinas in Real Estate*, and others.

Her work with Latina storytelling inspired the creation of the Fig Factor Foundation, a nonprofit development program for young Latinas ages 15-25. Through the Foundation, she has mentored more than 200 young Latinas towards their goals and recorded more than 200 TedX-style talks by young Latinas and seasoned professionals.

Jackie is among the 1% of Latina pilots in the county and promotes the aviation industry for Latinas through her multi-volume anthology series, *Latinas in Aviation*. The books contain personal and professional stories from Latinas in the aviation industry and inspired the founding of the nonprofit, *Latinas in Aviation*, to support aviation training for Latinas in the U.S. and South America. Jackie has partnered with aviation museums to create two permanent exhibits devoted to Latina aviators and helped pioneer an aviation program at the College of DuPage, her alma mater.

Jackie's penchant for marketing has led to the creation of products and brands relevant to her work. These include the Magix Board Game, the "Amazing" coffee brand, Today's Inspired Latina board game, and the Latinas in Aviation teddy bear, which have been distributed worldwide by the thousands. She has received more than 50 honors from universities and organizations for her entrepreneurship, business acumen, and elevation of Latinas. When not at home with her husband and business partner, Juan Pablo Ruiz, and her two children, Jackie travels the world giving countless keynote addresses and motivational talks in line with her life mission.

- Invited to the New York Times, 3 times.
- Featured in some of the most exclusive media outlets, including 3 magazine covers.
- Created the largest collection of Latina stories in a book anthology series, “Today’s Inspired Latina.”
- Created the first-ever Latinas in Aviation Global Festival along with the first-ever book, magazine.
- Created two nonprofit organizations, one in the US and one in Mexico.
- Currently learning Japanese and working on her second pilot’s license.

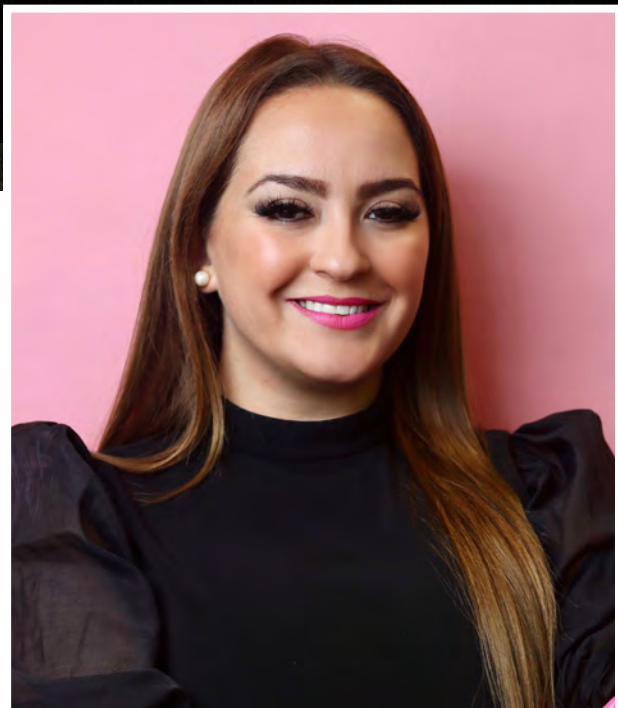

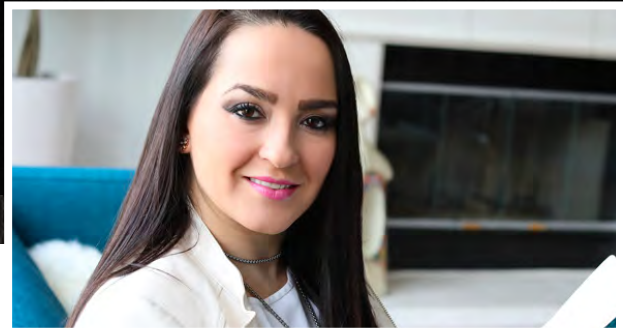

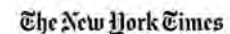

Jacqueline currently serves as a board member for the The Fig Factor Foundation, the Alumni Executive Board at the College of DuPage, LovePurse and the World Leaders Forum. She is a recent graduate of the DePaul University Women Entrepreneurship Cohort 3 and the Stanford University Graduate School of Business, Latino Business Action Network Cohort 11. She represents the 1.6% of women entrepreneurs with over seven figures in the United States.

Jacqueline is one of the very few Latina sports airplane pilots in the United States and the founder of Latinas in Aviation global brand. She believes that "taking off is optional, landing on your dreams is mandatory."
